3pm Wednesday: This will be a Meet'n'Greet at McP's Irish Pub and Grill. They have both inside seating and an outside patio. We will be outside, weather-permitting. It will be a "pay-as-you-go" bar and The Class will provide light snacks. If you wish to order a regular meal later on, they have an excellent menu with sandwiches and the very best clam chowder. Dress is casual, but bring a jacket. 1107 Orange Ave, across from the old Strand Theatre and Kippy's.

4:30 Thursday: Gather at the VFW for dinner with the VFW running "pay-as-you-go" bar. About 6:30 we'll walk to Niedermeyer Field to arrive about 6:45. Graduation ceremonies begin at 7pm. All attendees, including spouses and guests, will sit on the field as a group. After we are dismissed, we'll return to the VFW to continue with our merriment. Coat and tie NOT required, but dress like a teacher might dress around students. Again, bring a jacket, and ladies wear pants suits for warmth. 557 Orange Avenue - park anywhere around the area on Orange or around Central (Spreckles) Park.

5pm Friday: A steak BBQ at Bill and Chris (Vetter) Pate's house. If you attended the 45th Reunion, you have been there! Bill and Chris have graciously opened their home for our "post-graduation" festivities. This will be a relaxed chance to chat and catch-up. We want to take a 50th Reunion photograph, so don't miss this one! Casual, but bring a jacket. 1150 Glorietta Blvd...closer to the Yacht Club than the bridge.

2pm Saturday: A BBQ at the beach so you can enjoy the Pacific and beautiful views of Pt. Loma. We will be on the beach-side of the Amphib Base and will give the gate-guard a list of attendees if you don't have a military ID. This is a covered cabana area with restrooms, and a short walk down to the water. If you are local, bring a couple of lawn chairs to share. Drive down Orange Ave to the Strand, pass the Hotel Del and Boathouse, and enter right on Tarawa Road. Continue on that short street to the end/T and turn right. Stay on this road as it winds below the buildings and enters a gated area. The covered cabanas are on the left and we are in #6.

5pm Sunday: This is our traditional ending to all of our reunions, even when over the 4th of July - a nice way to end a busy week. The concerts run from Memorial Day to 2 weekends after Labor Day. Some of your classmates are there every Sunday during the summer, and many other classes have little groups nearby. We will have dinner in the park at 5pm, the concert begins at 6pm and runs to about 7 or 7:30. Casual - bring a jacket. (locals bring a couple of extra lawn chairs) Central Park b/w 6th and 7th - now called Spreckles Park. Look for our '61 banner.

You'll notice we mentioned bringing a jacket, 5x....SoCal is famous for its May-Grey and June-Gloom. We get a marine layer off the coast and it is usually cloudy in the morning, burning off by lunchtime. It is chilly again as soon as the sun goes down. Evenings don't warm up here until after the 4th of July. The football field could be chilly by 7pm! Maybe we'll get lucky and have early warm weather.....BE PREPARED!
